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RUAKAKA SLSP STANDARD CONDITIONS & REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL JUNIOR SURF MEMBERS & THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS

1. All (T)adpole and A Group children MUST have a parent / caregiver present with them on the beach. Please do not drop off your children and leave. For health and safety reasons, we ask for your support with this. If you are unable to have an adult present with your child on the beach, then we ask that you do not send your child or, alternatively, arrange for another caregiver to be present.
2. Junior Surf starts at 10:00am. Parents are urged to attend the brief squad meeting each Sunday held on the beach or at the clubhouse in their respective areas. These meetings (5—10 minutes) will be at the start of the session and advise that day's programme, upcoming events and any other issues that may arise.
3. All children must wear a Club skullcap (beanie) and Hi-vis vest during training. All children in A, B & C Group must hold a current 200m swim patch to be allowed into the water for the swim, board and associated events. If they have not yet gained this qualification, they will only be allowed in the water up to their waist, and will not be allowed on boards. This is a health and safety requirement.
4. All people who wish to contribute or participate directly with the Junior Surf training sessions as a coach, team manager, or coaching assistant (including parent helpers) must hold or obtain an Associate membership with Surf Lifesaving New Zealand. Please note that water assistants, like the children, must hold a current 200m swim badge for events and training in water above waist level.
5. As further protection for our junior members SLS Northern Region now requires that a police check be carried out on all adults in direct contact with children. This is a check for 'crimes against children and those of a vulnerable nature' only. Any concerns are notified to the SLSNR CEO only and are treated with utmost confidentiality.
6. Equipment is expensive to purchase and maintenance costs for repairs can have a significant impact on the Club. Children and their parents or caregivers must handle equipment responsibly and in accordance with club policy. Club equipment is for MEMBERS ONLY. Wash down and put away after use and please report immediately any damaged equipment to the Club.
7. We are all volunteers and give up our time freely for the benefit of the children, If you would like to become more involved with the Club, please see our volunteer boards, or speak to any member of the club committee about how you can help.

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CLUB RULES POLICY

CARE & USE OF THE RUAKAKA SLSP CLUBHOUSE AND EQUIPMENT

Rules for the use of the clubhouse:

1. Please treat these premises as you would your home.
2. Members & guests are requested to act in a responsible manner at all times that will reflect only goodwill towards our voluntary service.
3. The lounge, kitchen, bunkroom & toilet areas are a 'dry zone'. All wet bodies, wetsuits, swimwear and towels to be kept in the gear shed / shower area on the concrete floor.
4. Be a tidy kiwi and clean up your own mess.
5. Put things back where they belong, it'll be there next time you need it.
6. Overnight accommodation at the Ruakaka Surf Club is primarily for lifeguards rostered on patrol the following day.
 - All lifeguards under the age of 16 must have a parent/guardian stay with them at the clubhouse overnight. No alcohol is to be consumed by any person under the age of 18 unless they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
 - Lifeguards between the ages of 16 – 18 must have parent or guardian consent and the permission of the patrol captain and/or President.
7. The Patrol Captain or designate is responsible for the conduct of all persons on the premises.
8. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted outside the clubhouse.
9. Smoking is not permitted inside the clubhouse.
10. All members must abide by all District Council/Regional Council and Department of Conservation by-laws.

Security

Surf Life Saving Clubs are generally difficult to insure due to their remote location, please do your part to ensure the club is secure when you leave.

Three checks are required:

1. Smoke-stop doors must be closed. This includes the doors from both bunkrooms, and the doors at the end of the corridor
2. All lights are turned OFF and the alarm is set
3. Walk once around the outside of the building and check all doors and windows are securely locked

CARE & USE OF CLUB EQUIPMENT

Our main objectives are:

- To provide surf lifesaving services and prevent the loss of life
- To study and practice surf lifesaving methods
- To teach and train others in the techniques of surf lifesaving
- To support and encourage participation in competition.

Much of the equipment at the Club is essential for us to achieve these objectives.

Surfboards

Juniors are not to take boards from the gear shed without adult supervision.
Care must be taken when handling surfboards & skis on concrete surfaces.
Care must be taken not to damage skegs or fins when in shallow water.
All surfboards and skis must be rinsed in freshwater before being stowed away.
Competition boards are only to be used with approval by surf sports coach.
Do not use any boards or other equipment that is damaged.

Radios

Handheld radios must be protected by plastic waterproof jacket whenever removed from charger.

Quad/Bobcat

The quad/bobcat is only be used by members who have a current NZ driver's license, and operated in accordance with the Patrol Operations Manual.

Damaged equipment must be reported to the Gear Steward or your Patrol Captain.
